



Administration of Medication in School: What parents need to know

The Romulus Community Schools' Board of Education has a policy for the Administration of Medications for all students. Parents need to be aware that when possible medication should be administered at home. However if their child's well being depends upon medication being dispensed at school, as deemed necessary by a doctor, the following rules will be strictly enforced.

- All medications (prescription and non- prescription) must have an, Authorization for Administration of Medication, form signed by a medical doctor and a parent/guardian.
- All medications must be in the original pharmaceutical container.
- Medication must not be expired.
- Medication must be prescribed for the student.
- Any medication changes will require a new physician's order form.
- Students who will self administer medication must have written permission of a doctor and parent documented on file in the school.
- Self administered medications must be in a pharmaceutical container and include dosage and frequency of administration.
