Dear RHS Families:

Each year during the month of April, Romulus High School runs special schedules during State of Michigan Mandated Testing for 9th, 10th, and 11th grade students. This year these exams will take place on **April 9th, 10th, and 11th**. During testing, focus and attention to detail are highly encouraged. Therefore it is extremely important that students arrive on time for testing. Students will NOT be allowed to enter any testing area after 8:00am. Also, students MAY NOT bring backpacks on testing days. The required exams consist of a series of tests for the following groups:

- **Juniors:** The college readiness exam known as the SAT Plus Writing, WorkKeys, and M-STEP will be administered. The SAT score report can be used to apply for acceptance into colleges or universities and determines scholarship eligibility.
- **Sophomores:** PSAT 10
- **Freshmen:** PSAT 9

Monday, 4/08/19: All students report to school for a regular school day, 7:00am-2:04pm

Tuesday, 4/09/19: All Sophomores and Juniors will be the **only students in attendance (9th and 12th grades do not report)**. Sophomores and Juniors will report to school at the regular school start time. Buses will transport testing students to school at their regular morning pick up time. Breakfast and Lunch will be provided for testing students. Dismissal will be at the regular time (2:04 pm). **Students in 9th and 12th grades are required to complete the attached Field Experience Assignment.**

Wednesday, 4/10/19: Only Freshmen and Juniors (along with Sophomores who have been invited) will attend to complete testing. Breakfast and lunch will be provided to all students who are testing. Freshmen, Juniors, and invited Sophomores will report to school at the regular school time; buses will transport students at their regular morning pick up time. Dismissal will be at the regular time (2:04pm). **Students in 10th and 12th grades are required to complete the attached Field Experience Assignment.. Seniors must complete a total of two (2) assignments for the week.**

Thursday, 4/11/19: All Students report at the regular time; Juniors and select Sophomores will be testing. Breakfast and lunch will be provided to all students. Dismissal will be at the regular time (2:04pm).

Friday, 4/12/19: All students report to school for a regular school day.

In the rare event that a student needs to make-up any portion of these exams they are required to participate on the make-up dates, April 23-24, 2019. **IMPORTANT: Any student who does not complete their exams on these dates in April, 2019, as indicated will be required to take the entire assessment over again during the 2019-2020 school year.**

Wednesday, April 10th – only 9th and 11th grade students (and 10th grade students who are invited) will attend school. 10th grade will complete an at home Field Experience assignment. 12th grade will complete a second Field Experience assignment. See p. 3 for more details.

Thursday, April 11th – ALL students report to school at the normal time in the morning. All 9th and 11th grade students (and 10th grade students who are invited) will be testing. Remaining students will have a regular school day.

Dear Families of 9, 10th and 12th grade Eagles:

In an effort to promote college and career readiness, all students must complete an Independent Field Experience Assignment. The required activity allows students in 9th or 10th grade to spend one day researching their own career interests with an emphasis on the education and training paths necessary to reach their goals. Seniors are required to complete two (2) Field Experience Activities.

Option A:	<p><u>CAMPUS VISIT</u> Students schedule a campus visit at any local college or trade school. Students are required to bring back admissions literature from the post secondary institution. Students should log into Career Cruising and record which school they visited on their EDP list of activities. A Field Experience Activity form will be available on 4/8/2019 on Student Connect under School Links. Parents should complete this Google form to verify the activity has been completed.</p>
Option B:	<p><u>JOB SHADOWING</u> Students visit the workplace of any field they are interested in. Students should log into Career Cruising and add the work visit and activity summary on their EDP list of activities. A Field Experience Activity form will be available on 4/8/2019 on Student Connect under School Links. Parents should complete this Google form to verify the activity has been completed.</p>
Option C:	<p><u>CAREER RESEARCH PROJECT</u> Students visit at least 5 Post-Secondary planning websites to gather information about their education and career path. Websites can be accessed via smartphone. The following 5 sites are required. *www.workforce.resa.net *pathfinder.mitalent.org *https://collegescorecard.ed.gov *www.collegeboard.org *www.Careercruising.com Once students have visited the first three sites, they will log on to Career Cruising to save the new schools and career paths to their EDP. A Field Experience Activity form will be available on 4/8/2019 on Student Connect under School Links. Parents should complete this Google form to verify the activity has been completed.</p>
Option D:	<p><u>COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP COMPLETION</u> Students are required to search for scholarships and complete at least one application. Students may pick up scholarship applications from the counseling office or complete an application they find online. The name of the scholarship completed should be added to their Career Cruising Scholarship List found on their EDP. A Field Experience Activity form will be available on 4/8/2019 on Student Connect under School Links. Parents should complete this Google form to verify the activity has been completed.</p>

TUESDAY, APRIL 9TH: 9TH AND 12 GRADE students are required to complete one of the activities above. All students should log into their Career Cruising account to record the activity as well as complete the Google **Field Experience Activity form to verify the activity has been completed.**

WEDNESDAY APRIL 10th: 10th and 12th GRADE students are required to complete one of the activities above. All students should log into their Career Cruising account to record the activity as well as complete the Google **Field Experience Activity form to verify the activity has been completed.**

If students are unable to access their Career Cruising account before their activity date, they should contact our college adviser Ms. Barden at 734-532-1038 on test days to get their login information or to get help with any of the activities.
